The purpose of the Hilda Neatby Prize in Women's and Gender History, awarded since 1982 by the Canadian Committee in Women's History at the Annual Meeting of the Canadian Historical Association, is to encourage the publication of scholarly articles on women's and gender history in Canada.

Two prizes shall be awarded if eligibility criteria are met:

FRENCH LANGUAGE PRIZE: Any French-language academic article published in a Canadian or international journal or in an edited collection in 2025 and deemed to make an original and scholarly contribution to the field of women's and gender history in Canada is eligible for nomination for the 2026 Hilda Neatby Prize.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PRIZE: Any English-language academic article published in a Canadian or international journal or in an edited collection in 2025 and deemed to make an original and scholarly contribution to the field of women's and gender history in Canada is eligible for nomination for the 2026 Hilda Neatby Prize.
