

Call for Nominations

Canadian Committee on Women's and Gender History Book Prize

The Canadian Committee on Women's and Gender History invites nominations for the CCWGH Book Prize to be awarded in 2026 at the annual meeting of the Canadian Historical Association.

This book prize is awarded every two years to the best book published in the previous two years, in either English or French, in the field of women's and gender history.

Criteria

To be eligible for the prize, the nominated book must:

- have been published in 2024 or 2025.
- deal with some facet of women's or gender history EITHER in Canada OR in another part of the world, provided the author lives and works in Canada.
- be a monograph (edited collections and translated works are not eligible).

At least five books meeting these eligibility requirements must be nominated for the prize to be awarded.

The deadline for nominations is **January 1, 2026**. Authors or publishers should send a copy of each submission, in either hard copy or digital format, to each member of the prize committee:
